

The Glasgow Park Project

Help us Revitalize our park!

Thank you for your interest in The Glasgow Park project! In March 2010, the Parklawn Civic Association received \$5,000 in grant money from Fairfax County's Neighborhood Enhancement Partnership Program (NEPP) for the "Glasgow Park Project." There were 32 projects selected to receive funding out of a total of 63 applicants.

We will be using the funds to build a kiosk, plant additional trees, and pay for the **Family Fun Fair** on June 12, from 11am—4pm. (Rain date: June 13) This event will feature several local bands, moon bounces, food and fun for all ages. It will also serve to raise awareness of our park's location and celebrate our community.

Because the playground equipment is so expensive, additional funds will be raised to pay for the equipment at the fun fair and through future fundraisers.

Here is the "wish list" of some ideas for improvements we are currently pursuing:

- Put in a community bulletin board/park rules "kiosk" with a roof/cover.
- Extend the play area of the park behind the swing sets where the fence is broken and add additional equipment for older children.
- Add more climbing equipment for toddler and equipment which promotes physical activity for elementary school age children.
- Add overhead parallel bars suitable for younger children (about 3-1/2 feet above the ground) which could also be the base of a connector bridge connecting the existing equipment with the new equipment.
- Add Corkscrew Climber, Storefront Panel, Tire Swing and Climbing Wall
- Add soft rubber base under climbing equipment
- Connect the concrete trail so that children can ride bikes/trikes, and walkers/runners can walk/run around the playground area of the park.
- Plant some shade providing trees closer the playground
